Well equipped with modern facilities the library is with area of 155 Sqm. Seating capacity 100 persons and follow open access system. Our collection has over 10833 volumes of books with 1407 Titles. The college subscribed about 40 National and International Journals. And E-journals like DELNET, NDLI, e-Shodhsindhu

Admission to the Library

Students are allowed to library only of production of their authorised valid Identify cards. Person who is not a member of the library should not be admitted into the library. However Non-members should be admitted only by the special permit to be

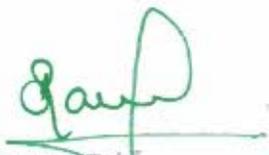

Digital Library was established 20 systems with high speed Internet connection. Open Access catalogue (OPAC) is extended to students through Pentium system. The Barcode scanning facility at the library is on par with that most, modern libraries and it helps keep track issue and return of books.

Journal Section

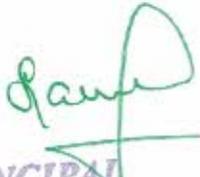
In this section journal, magazines and News letter are available. They are arranged Subject wise .The latest issues are displayed on display rack and other previous issues are arranged in the drawer.

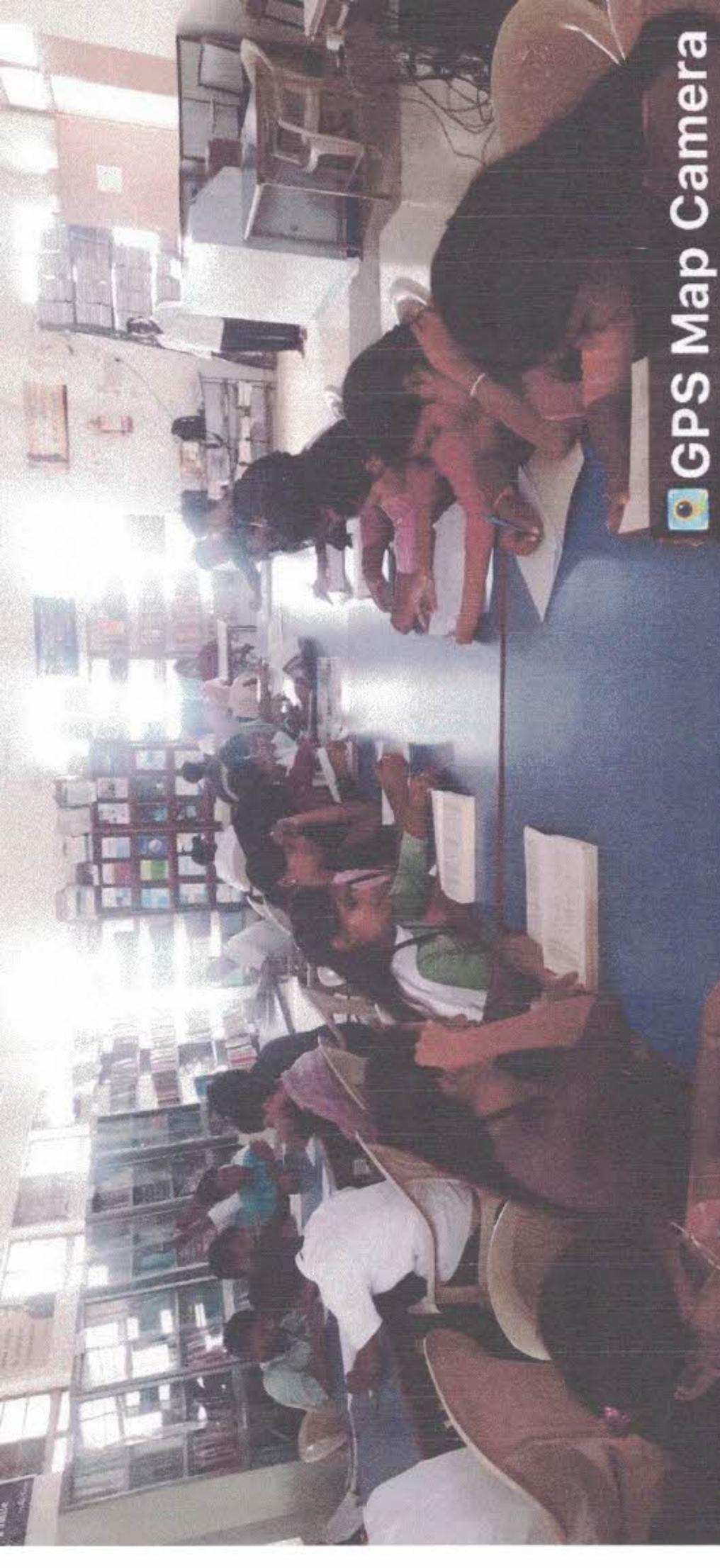
Care of Library Books

4.2.1 Library is automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)

Response:

- Library automation is extremely important in this age of technology as there is tremendous growth in the different fields of knowledge and need for access to the desired literature Balaji institute of pharmaceutical Sciences has taken an initiative to move its library towards paperless functioning through the use of automated library management software. It is difficult to have access to the desired literature with manually operated devices. Library automation enables acquisition, cataloguing and circulation
- The Automated Library System used by the institute is an Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) with interoperability means/interfaces for different kinds of systems at the institution level. It also means interfaces for similar systems at the inter-organizational level, as a result of which resource sharing and collaboration can now be taken to a whole new level. The ILMS is no longer the poor cousin in the e-learning / e-knowledge landscape.
- An ILMS is usually comprised of a relational database and software to act on that database and two graphical user interfaces (one for patrons, one for staff). Most of the ILMS software functions in discrete programs called modules, which are then integrated into a unified interface. 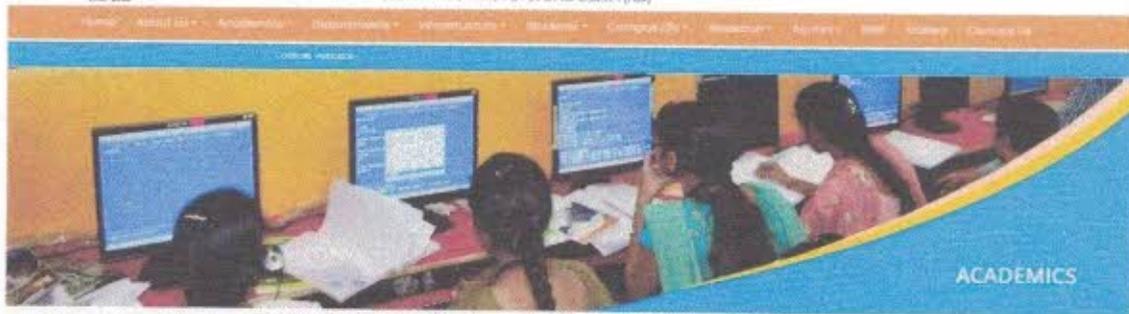

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Learning Management System (LMS) & E – Learning Resources

Information & Communications Technology (ICT) enabled teaching methodologies are being followed by the faculty members in class rooms.

The academic plan with budget, notes of lesson, lab manuals and question banks with key are made available at the very beginning of the semester.

The use of multimedia teaching aids like, LCD projectors, smart classrooms and internet enabled computer systems are usually employed in classroom.

The electronic resource packages like DELNET , National Digital Library (NDL) e-ShodhSindhu are available. The faculty members effectively utilize Audio Visual aids to demonstrate the concepts to the students using the resources from National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) to enhance the learning experience.

Hard disk containing web and video courses (offline) from NPTEL are accessible to faculty and students from the server installed in the library. These courses are the part of LMS.

Sufficient number of books, Journals, e-journals and e-books are available in the library. The research journals are available online and facility for accessing these journals is provided through proxy server in the campus.

Every year, all the departments conduct seminars, workshops and guest lectures on the new developments in the core subjects for effective teaching and learning by the faculty members and students.

Research laboratory and communication skill laboratory help the faculty to enhance knowledge in the field of English communication and writing skills.

Seminar hall is equipped with multimedia facilities. Invited talks and webinars are conducted in seminar hall using ICT facilities.

Academic Management System

The college has developed an integrated Academic Management System and comprehensive tool for faculty, students and administrators to overcome the challenges in the process of college admissions and post admission. The entire college admission process was proposed to be digitized with the tool starting from Application, Selection, and Intimation & Admissions. The tool is an online-platform that is meant to manage entire gambit of CBCS – from registration of course, registration by the faculty, allocation of courses to the faculty, student attendance, internal assessment, end-semester assessment, and conversion of marks to grades, declaration of results, grade card generation, distribution etc
